

Take Highway 113 (off Interstate 80), then take the Hutchison Drive Exit. Proceed east on Hutchison Drive until you reach Haring Hall (left side of road). Free parking is available in Lots 29 and 43. Room 2205 is located on the second floor of Haring Hall (enter on the south side of building).

ETHICS TRAINING

Ethics training will be offered to those interested PRIOR to the start of the official AVS Day program on February 7th. Market Poultry (Broiler Pens and Meat Turkeys), market steer, and market lamb exhibitors at the 2004 California State Fair will be required to participate in a California State Fair Certified Quality Assurance Program and Ethics Training prior to the opening of the 2004 California State Fair.

Those exhibitors who received Tier III certification at AVS Day 2003 or at other location in 2003 do NOT need to repeat the training in 2004 (that was a 5 year certification). Attending a Certified Quality Assurance Program and Ethics Training Seminar in 2004 will fulfill the training requirement for 2004, 5,6, 7 and 8. Other species groups may be added in the future.

POULTRY HEALTH INSPECTION (PHI) CERTIFICATION

There will be mandatory poultry health inspection of all birds at all California fairs in 2004. Trained people will be needed. You are eligible for training if you are 19 years and older or a high school graduate. Fairs will have funding to hire PH Inspectors for their coop-in period. We are encouraging each county to have a team of PH Inspectors - possibly a 4-H leader, APA judge, 4-H alumnus/a, and a veterinarian.

Some 30 PH Inspectors were certified in early December. The state needs more. If you are interested, call Jeri Hansen at 530 752-9040 immediately. You may leave a voice message. Be sure to clearly state your NAME, MAILING ADDRESS, and PHONE NUMBER. The class is limited to the first 30 to register by phone. The first 30 people will receive a confirmation from Jeri. Children will not be allowed in the PHI certification room. We will make arrangements for Avian Sciences students to supervise the children of the 30 adults being certified.
