This year's 4-H National Poultry and Egg Conference took place in November in a very cold Louisville, Kentucky. "How cold was it?" Well, in the entire history of horse racing at Churchill Downs, the racing card has only been cancelled four times. Two of the four were the Wednesday and Thursday of this year's National Conference.

Chilly temperatures did not weaken the resolve of our California State Avian Bowl Champions. Of the 13 states competing, the California team had the highest average team score on the written test used for seeding of the actual Avian Bowl. The two Shasta County 4-Hers who made up our State team, Kutter Wright and Emma Osborn, ran the winners' bracket. They defeated North Carolina, Kentucky, and Pennsylvania on their way to taking it all.

How did our team of two from California become so successful? Well, they started as Juniors in Avian Bowl, attending competitions in the far north of the state and the State Qualifier. This is the first year the team was eligible for senior competition and took the State Championship, with Mrs. Kris Wright as their Coach. Following their victory this past February in Fresno, they continued to hone their skills by taking in as many

Avian Bowl competitions as possible. This included traveling all the way to Costa Mesa to participate in the very competitive Avian Bowl at the Orange County Fair.

I want to congratulate both Kutter and Emma, as well as their support team of Mrs. Wright and Mrs. Gabriela Osborn. Not only were these Californians responsible for bringing the Avian Bowl title back to the Golden State, they were also friendly California Ambassadors at the national event.

Multiple trams in the same age division may be entered from the same county. You may also make up a team with individual members coming from different counties.

HOW TO ORER THE NATIONAL AVIAN BOWL MANUAL

The National Avian Bowl Manual is available from the Clemson University Publishing Bulletin Room. The cost is \$15.00 per copy (plus shipping charges) and may be ordered online using a major credit card by going to the following website: <u>http://shopping.clemson.edu</u> When the Clemson Shopping page comes up, enter **Man161** (NO spaces between the alpha and numeric) in the Search Products Box.

There is no tax, and the Priority Mail (2-3 days) shipping charge is \$12.05 (1 copy to California). This is cheaper than ground shipping. Shipping charges will vary when ordering multiple copies.

If you must **pay by check** (rather than credit card), you may call 1-888-772-2665 to make arrangements and ask for help in calculating shipping charges for the total invoice.
