California Trio returns home with National Championship

The 2015 4-H National Poultry and Egg Conference in Louisville, Kentucky was another outstanding experience for California 4-Hers. Our State Champions: Keaton Kelm, Ellie Milanesa, and Téa Rice, took advantage of all the Conference offers. They attended the Career Workshop, all the tours, mixer, North American International Livestock Exposition, awards banquet, and, of course, the National Avian Bowl.

In addition to the Californians, this year's National Avian Bowl had 4-Hers competing from Georgia, Illinois, Kentucky, Louisiana, Minnesota, New Jersey, New York, Ohio, and Vermont. California entered the competition seeded second. Their average team score on the written test was a fraction of a point lower than that of the New York team. Historically, with only a couple of exceptions, the team seeded first has won the contest.

In a match-up seen many times at the Nationals, California took on Kentucky in Game 1 and beat them. The New Yorkers defeated Georgia in their first game. However, in their second game, the New Yorkers were shocked by a fast Ohio team and fell into the Loses' Bracket. California ran the Winners' Bracket, beating Minnesota and Ohio. Minnesota went on to run the Losers' Bracket and faced California again. The

Minnesotans were out to win and defeated the Californians the second time they faced them. This resulted in another game, as both California and Minnesota had a loss. All three Californians hit their buzzers with speed and correct answers in that final game for a resounding win.

The California Team was coached by Mrs. Shar Rice. She collected her second National Avian Bowl Coach's award, having coached another National Championship team several years ago.

HOW TO ORER THE NATIONAL AVIAN BOWL MANUAL

The National Avian Bowl Manual is available from the Clemson University Publishing Bulletin Room. The cost is \$15.00 per copy (plus shipping charges) and may be ordered online using a major credit card by going to the following website: <u>http://shopping.clemson.edu</u> When the Clemson Shopping page comes up, enter **Man161** (NO spaces between the alpha and numeric) in the Search Products Box.

There is no tax, and the Priority Mail (2-3 days) shipping charge is \$12.05 (1 copy to California). This is cheaper than ground shipping. Shipping charges will vary when ordering multiple copies.

If you must **pay by check** (rather than credit card), you may call 1-888-772-2665 to make arrangements and ask for help in calculating shipping charges for the total invoice.
